Epiphany Athletic Voucher System

1. The purpose of the Epiphany Athletic Voucher System is to:
 - Gain parental assistance at the sporting events and during athletic fundraisers.
 - Gain financial support for Epiphany athletics.

2. How the Epiphany Athletic Voucher System works.
 - Each family, whether your child is on a competitive team or on an intramural league, is required to volunteer five hours during the school year working at any athletic fundraiser such as concession stand, score keeping, coaching, line judging, or chaperoning Middle School dances.
 - A \$50 deposit check is due with the registration form for your child’s sport.
 - The deposit check will be returned to you upon completion of your five hours.
 - If you would rather pay for your hours rather than volunteer, write “CASH” on the memo line of the check.
 - You may pick up additional voucher slips in the school office, the concession stand, or the athletic office.

3. After you have worked your hour(s), please fill out a voucher form and return it to the school office. **Please DO NOT return your slips before you have actually worked the event. Fill out the form completely to receive full credit.**

4. If we have not received confirmation of your five volunteer hours worked, nor have you paid for them by the end of the school year, your deposit check will be cashed.
