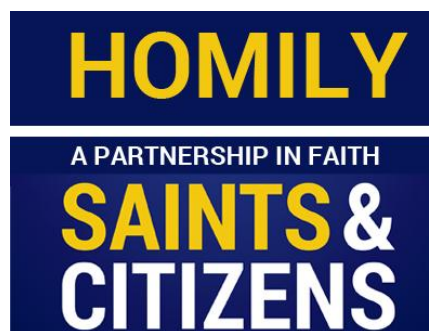
Return completed registration materials by Thursday March 9, 2017 and you will receive a \$100 credit for the 2017.18 school year that will be applied to the final payment.

Spotlight on the Handbook. Tardiness/Absences - Students are expected to attend school for the entire school day, 7:40 AM-2:10 pm. Students arriving late, leaving for any part of the day, or leaving before 2:10 pm need to report to the school office and **must have a parent/guardian sign them in or out.**

- A student is tardy if he/she arrives after 7:40 am.
- A student is considered absent for a half day if he/she misses more than three hours of the day.
- A student is considered absent for a full day if he/she misses four or more hours of the school day.

If your child is absent for an extended period or on a recurring basis the Principal or teacher, may contact your family to discuss the situation in an effort to improve attendance.
