Kindergarten Open House

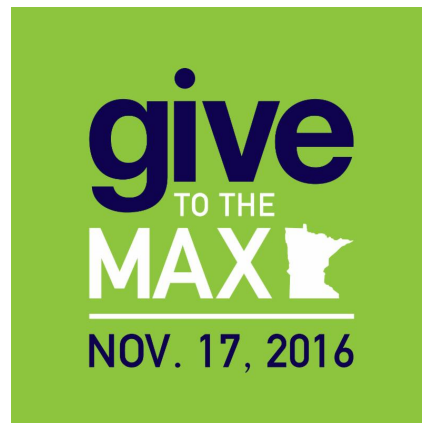
