Our Uniform Policy is designed to reflect the modesty taught by our Catholic tradition. It enhances a sense of school pride and belonging, while encouraging discipline and eliminating unnecessary distractions. Additionally, it creates opportunities to share our mission in the wider community.

Students are expected to follow the Uniform Policy as written. Administration and teachers reserve the right to decide if a student is out of uniform or in violation of the dress code. If students are out of uniform or in violation of the dress code policy, they will be issued a conduct slip and provided a uniform from our used uniform stock. If replacement options are not available from our used uniforms, parents will be called to bring an acceptable uniform for the student.

GIRLS' UNIFORM, Grades K-5

Plaid: Jumper, Plaid Split Skirt. Skirt (2 inches above the knee)
Blouse: Plain white or red uniform **logo** polo (long or short sleeve)
Pants/shorts: Classic cut navy blue twill or corduroy (5 inch seam for shorts)
Sweaters: Navy blue cardigan, school crew neck sweatshirt, or v-neck vest with logo
Socks: Knee-highs, tights or anklets, solid navy, or white

BOYS' UNIFORM, Grades K-5

Shirt: Plain white or red uniform **logo** polo shirt (long or short sleeve).
Pants/shorts: Classic cut navy blue twill or corduroy logo
Sweaters: Navy blue v-neck vest with a white button down oxford or school crew neck sweatshirt with
Epiphany logo.
Socks: Solid blue or white

BOYS' AND GIRLS' UNIFORM SHORTS/CAPRI, Grades K-8

Navy blue shorts with a 5" inseam. Solid navy (and khaki for middle school) Capri pants are also allowed.

GRADES 6-7-8 UNIFORM FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

Shirts:	White or navy logo polo (long or short sleeve) with the Epiphany logo.
Pants:	Classic navy or khaki twill pants or corduroy.
Shorts/Skirt:	Classic navy or khaki twill (5 inch inseam) Girls may wear a navy blue skirt (2 inches above the knee). Girls may also wear Capri pants
Sweaters:	School crew neck sweatshirt with logo, v-neck vest with white button down oxford shirt.
Socks:	Solid blue or white

UNIFORM PROCEDURES FOR ALL K-8 STUDENTS

- Students wear shirts tucked in at all times.
- Boots can only be worn to and from school and during recess.
- Undershirts are plain white under the uniform shirt.
- Socks are worn with shoes.
- Shoes are black/brown dress shoes or sneakers. Shoes should not be distracting in any way. Lights, wheels, etc. are not permitted

NOT PERMITTED

- No denim, cargo pants, or sweats.
- Jackets or hoodies are not part of the uniform.
- No clogs, flip-flops, fashion boots, shoes with lights, or Uggs are to be worn.
- Shorts are not to be worn at school liturgies. Shorts and capris may be worn in September, October, and April 1 through the end of the school year
- Hairstyles and hair coloring (e.g. highlights, coloring, extensions, etc.) should not draw undue attention to the student. No hair can be dyed a color that cannot be grown naturally. Hats and bandanas may not be worn during the school day unless approved for a specific theme day. Questions or concerns will be handled by the administration.
- No body piercings or tattoos. Girls may wear stud earrings. Extreme piercings, even in the ears (spacers, gauges, or other piercings) are prohibited.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION DRESS CODE

- Students in grades K-5 wear tennis shoes and school uniform (girls may wear shorts under jumper).
- Students in Middle School wear a Physical Education Uniform (shorts and shirt), socks and tennis shoes.

Cost of PhyEd uniforms is approximately \$20.00. Uniforms must be purchased through the PhyEd Department. Orders will be taken during the first week of school. Replacement uniforms can be obtained during the school year if necessary.
