



## Grades K-5 ALL-SCHOOL and ALL-CLASS Remote Learning Expectations

When our school, or a K-5 classroom, needs to move to remote learning due to quarantine or illness, we will use the following guidelines for remote learning:

1. ***Every school day, students must log into their Google Classroom/Site at their assigned homeroom time;*** times are listed below.
2. ***Daily homeroom is a live Google Meet*** for students to see their teacher, ask questions, and connect with one another. During Google Meets, students are expected to:
  - Keep their microphones off until instructed by the teacher to turn them on,
  - Keep their camera on so that the teacher and classmates can see one another,
  - Be in a location conducive to learning with as few distractions as possible,
  - Follow general classroom rules of etiquette including: no eating, drinking, or use of other electronic devices; wear appropriate attire (school uniform not required), no hats or clothing that blocks the face.
3. ***Attendance will be taken daily during homeroom.*** Because of this, it's important for K-5 students to attend their homeroom session daily. Homeroom sessions will vary in length but be about 15-30 minutes.
4. ***Homeroom Schedules:***
  - Grades K-4 offer two homeroom options daily; students may attend one or both:
    - K Homeroom: 9:00 am or 12:30 pm
    - 1st Grade: 8:30 am or 1:00 pm
    - 2nd Grade: 8:00 am or 1:30 pm
    - 3rd Grade: 9:30 am or 2:00 pm
    - 4th Grade: 8:30 am or 12:30 pm
  - Grade 5 follows their regular daily schedule and begins at 7:45 am daily
5. ***Outside of homeroom, students should follow the daily instructions*** provided by their teacher and found in their Google Classroom/Site.
6. ***Assignments must be submitted by the date*** established by the teacher. If this is not possible, parents are asked to contact the teacher via email to make other arrangements.
