Our Preschool Students:

3 years old by September 1st of the school year through 5 years old AND fully toilet trained

- Class options:
 - Full Day-5: Monday-Friday, 7:30 am – 2:30 pm
 - Full Day-3: Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday, 7:30 am – 2:30 pm
 - Half Day- 5: Monday-Friday, 7:30 am – 11:30 am

Tuition:

- Full Day-5: \$8,600
- Full Day-3: \$5,300
- Half Day-5: \$6,500

Our School Day:

- School Day start time
 - All programs start promptly at 7:30 am
 - Drop off starting at 7:15 am
 - Arrival by 7:20 am for breakfast option
- School day end time:
 - Part Time promptly at 11:30 am
 - Full Time promptly at 2:30 pm
 - Must be picked up by 2:45 pm
- Meals and Snacks
 - All meals are included in tuition cost
 - Breakfast available for students arriving by 7:20 am
 - Lunch for all preschoolers
 - Afternoon snack provided for Full Day students

A Blended Approach to Early Childhood Education

- Beginning in the fall of 2025, Epiphany Catholic Preschool will embrace a thoughtfully integrated approach, blending the best elements of Traditional and Montessori education within a faith-filled Catholic environment. While we will continue as a traditional preschool classroom, we will also incorporate hands-on, multi-sensory experiences inspired by the Montessori method, reflecting the strengths of both approaches while staying true to our Catholic identity.
- Children will explore through their senses—smell, sight, hearing, and touch—as they engage with a variety of materials and textures. Early literacy is supported through playful sound games, word exploration, and the Believe and Read literacy program, helping students build a strong foundation for reading.
- In mathematics, we utilize the Singapore Math Curriculum, which focuses on concrete, hands-on activities that make abstract concepts accessible and fun—fostering a lifelong love of learning.
- Enhancements to our learning spaces, including a newly developed music and large motor movement room with Catholic elements, further support the holistic development of each child—body, mind, and soul.
- At Epiphany, we are committed to nurturing wonder, forming virtue, and helping each child encounter the love of God in joyful, meaningful ways every day.
